

IDCOP REIMBURSEMENT TRAVEL GRANT FOR ATC

I am pleased to announce that the AST Infectious Disease Community of Practice (IDCOP) will be awarding **two reimbursement Trainee Travel Grants of \$1,000 each** for the upcoming 2019 American Transplant Congress (ATC).

Qualifications for the Trainee Travel Grant

- Current Trainee member of AST
- Current member of the IDCOP (since January 2019)
- Trainee Grant applicant must be the lead author of the research project
- Research project abstract must have been submitted and accepted for presentation (oral presentation or poster) at the 2019 ATC

Application Materials Needed to Apply for the Travel Grant

- Letter from the Trainee's research mentor confirming trainee status, role in the research, and demonstrated need for funding to attend ATC 2019
- ATC abstract
- ATC abstract acceptance letter
- Trainee Applicant CV or résumé

The applications will be judged on the research quality, impact, and novelty. Trainee Grant recipients will be expected to present their research at ATC and will be recognized at the IDCOP Business Meeting.
