

KPCOP REIMBURSEMENT TRAVEL GRANT FOR ATC

Dear Colleagues,

I am pleased to announce that the AST Kidney Pancreas Community of Practice (KPCOP) will be awarding **two reimbursement Trainee Travel Grants of \$1,000 each** for the upcoming 2019 American Transplant Congress (ATC).

Trainee Travel Grant Qualifications:

- Current Trainee member of AST
- Current member of the KPCOP
- Trainee Grant applicant must be the lead author of the research project
- Research project abstract must have been submitted and accepted for presentation (oral presentation or poster) at the 2019 ATC

Please note that recipients of other travel awards (ATC Young Investigator Award or other COP Travel Grants) are NOT eligible to apply for the KPCOP Trainee Travel Grant

Application Must Include the Following:

- Letter from the Trainee's research mentor confirming trainee status, role in the research, and demonstrated need for funding to attend ATC 2019
- ATC abstract
- ATC abstract acceptance letter
- Trainee Applicant CV or résumé

The applications will be judged on the research quality and originality. Trainee Grant recipients will be expected to present their research at ATC and will be recognized at the KPCOP Business Meeting.
