I am pleased to announce that the AST Women's Health Community of Practice (WHCOP) will be awarding **one \$1,000 reimbursement Trainee Travel Grant** for the upcoming 2019 American Transplant Congress (ATC).

Qualifications for the reimbursement Trainee Travel Grant

- Current Trainee member of AST
- Current member of the WHCOP (as of January 2019)
- Trainee Grant applicant must be the lead author of the research project
- Research project abstract must be accepted for presentation (oral presentation or poster) at the 2019 ATC

Application Must Include:

- Letter from the Trainee's research mentor confirming trainee status, role in the research, and demonstrated need for funding to attend ATC 2019
- ATC abstract
- ATC abstract acceptance letter
- Trainee CV

The applications will be judged on the research quality, impact, and novelty. Trainee Grant recipients will be expected to present their research at ATC and will be recognized at the WHCOP Business Meeting. The deadline for applications is **March 18, 2019**.

Please note that if Trainee Grant applicants have already received an ATC travel award (e.g., the ATC Young Investigator Travel Award, another COP Trainee Travel Grant, etc.), the WHCOP Trainee Travel Grants will be awarded to other applicants.
